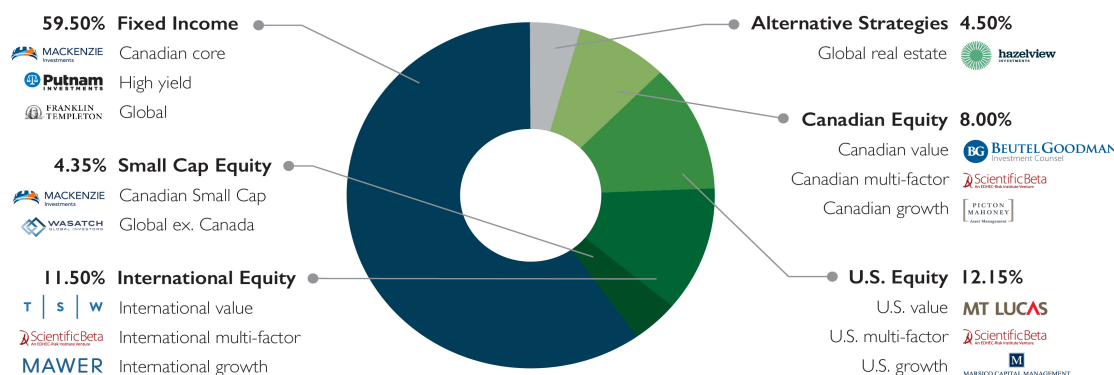

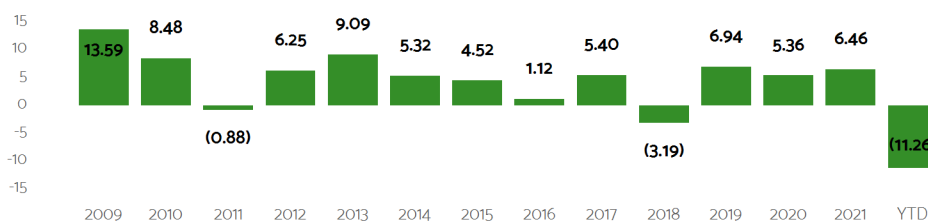
Target Portfolio Allocation*

Performance (%) Calendar Year Returns

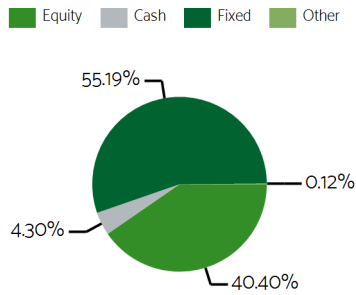


Historical Performance (\$) Current Value of a \$10,000 Investment

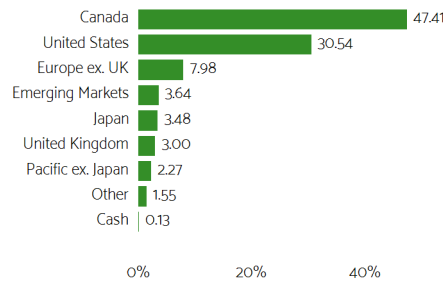


Your Portfolio Mix

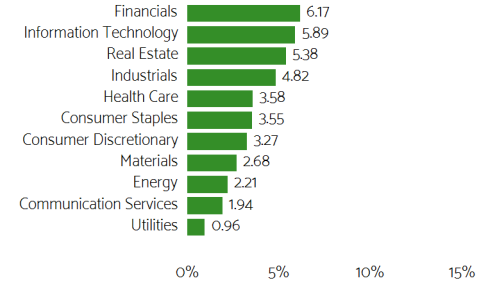
Asset Class Mix
